**AN ACT Relating to the State Boxing Commission.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1939, c. 282, § 9, amended.** Section 9 of chapter 282 of the public laws of 1939, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the 3rd paragraph thereof, the following:

**, but when application, by a well reputed fraternal, charitable or patriotic organization, for holding amateur boxing contests, is made to the commission, it shall grant such license and without the requirement of the payment of the fees hereinbefore enumerated.'**
