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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Propagation of Lobsters.**

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**Rearing station for propagation of lobsters, established. Resolved:**  
That the sum of \$40,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated for the purpose of establishing a lobster hatchery and rearing station for the propagation of lobsters; the same to be expended under the direction of the department of sea and shore fisheries.
