IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Smelts in Waters of Androscoggin Watershed.

Androscoggin watershed; smelt fishing, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making it unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any smelt at any time in all waters of the Androscoggin watershed above middle dam, said dam being located at the outlet of Mooselookmeguntic lake.
