RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in East and West Richardson Ponds, in Oxford County.

Fishing in East and West Richardson ponds; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a rule and regulation making a daily bag limit of 4 fish to be taken from the East and West Richardson ponds, situated in Adamstown (T. 4, R. 2) and Lincoln plantation, in the county of Oxford. Tributaries closed.
