RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters.

Fishing in certain waters; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making the daily bag limit of 3 fish to be taken from the following waters:

Rangeley lake, located in the town of Rangeley, Rangeley plantation and Sandy River plantation, county of Franklin;

Mooselucmeguntic lake, located in the town of Rangeley, Rangeley plantation, Richardson and Adamstown (T. 4, R. 2), counties of Oxford and Franklin;

Cupsuptic lake, located in Adamstown (T. 4, R. 2), Rangeley and Lower Cupsuptic towns, counties of Franklin and Oxford.
