RESOLVE, in Favor of a Lookout Tower in New Gloucester.

Lookout tower to be established in New Gloucester. Resolved: That the sum of \$1000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid out of the general funds to build a lookout tower on Little Hill, so-called, on the Chandler Mill property in the town of New Gloucester under the direction of the department of forestry.
