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**AN ACT Repealing Bounty on Bears in Aroostook County.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 79, amended.** The first sentence of section 79 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Except in the county of Aroostook** when bears are found destroying property in any town, plantation or unincorporated place, the assessors of such town or plantation, may petition the commissioner of inland fisheries and game to place a bounty on bears killed within such town or plantation or in any adjoining town, plantation or unincorporated place or places, and in the case of unincorporated places, a similar petition may be filed by the assessors of any adjoining town or of the nearest incorporated town where there are none adjoining, to place a bounty on bears killed within such unincorporated place.'
