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**AN ACT Relating to Trapping for Beaver.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended.** Paragraph (e) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(e) Provided, further, that whoever at any time hunts or traps for or has in his possession any beaver, or part thereof, except as provided in the preceding section, and whoever molests or destroys a beaver house **or dam, except under the supervision of a warden,** or sets a trap within ~~25~~ **35** feet ~~thereof of the center or crown of the house,~~ shall be subject to the penalties of this chapter.’
