**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Clayton and Fish Lakes of the Fish River Chain of Lakes.**

---

**Fishing in Clayton and Fish lakes of the Fish River chain of lakes; regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, establishing May 1st as the opening date on which it shall be legal to fish for salmon and trout in Clayton and Fish lakes of the Fish River chain of lakes in Aroostook county.
