**RESOLVE, For Screening Outlet of Minnehonk Lake.**

---

**Minnehonk lake at Mt. Vernon; screening of. Resolved:** That the sum of \$200 be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be taken from the general funds of the state, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to screen the outlet of Minnehonk lake at Mt. Vernon in the county of Kennebec; provided, however, that no appropriation hereafter specified for the erection of a screen at the outlet of said lake shall be available until the town in which the outlet of the lake to be screened is situated, or some other town in the county in which said waters are situated, shall have in legal town meeting, and having an article in warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, vote to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.
