RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Narraguagus River.

Fishing on Narraguagus river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation making it legal to fish within 25 feet of fishways on the Narraguagus river in the county of Washington.
