RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Chain of Ponds.

Fishing in chain of ponds, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing, except fly fishing and trolling with fly only, chain of ponds in Township 2, Range 6, county of Franklin.
