AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Ogunquit Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1913, c. 203, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 203 of the private and special laws of 1913, as amended by chapter 53 of the private and special laws of 1939, is hereby further amended by striking out all of the amendment added by said chapter 53 of the private and special laws of 1939 and inserting in place thereof the following:

‘The inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation are hereby empowered and authorized to issue bonds in the name of Ogunquit Village Corporation for the purpose of raising money with which to defray the expenses attendant upon the “Perkins Cove Harbor Project”, so-called, which is hereby authorized. Said bonds shall not exceed in total amount the sum of \$35,000, due and payable serially in 20 years. Said bonds shall be of such denomination, dates of maturity and of such rate of interest as the legal voters present at any regular or special meeting of said Ogunquit Village Corporation called for such purpose, may determine. Said bonds when authorized by vote of said Ogunquit Village Corporation, as aforesaid, duly sealed and signed by its treasurer and board of overseers shall be the legal obligation of said Ogunquit Village Corporation.’
