Reed Plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Reed plantation the sum of \$500 to install a water system in Wytopitlock high and grade school building in said Reed plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS The school building has been condemned by the authorities. The plantation is unable to finance this project.
