IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Relating to Purchase of Land by State.

State authorized to purchase certain land. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$5000 for the purpose of buying the land and the buildings thereon situated on the northwest corner of the junction of Grove and Capitol streets in Augusta.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above mentioned property may be purchased at the discretion of the governor and council for such portion of the above mentioned appropriation as may seem advisable to them.
