RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Fort Fairfield.

Fort Fairfield; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$600.60 to be paid to the town of Fort Fairfield to compensate it for the expense incurred in the support of a pauper of the town of Van Buren.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above pauper was a charge of the town of Van Buren, which is under the charge of the state. The claim could not be established in time to comply with the law.
