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**AN ACT Relating to the Maintenance of a Public Building in Rumford.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1915, c. 116, § 2, amended.** Section 2 of chapter 116 of the private and special laws of 1915 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Beginning with the year 1941, the county of Oxford shall pay to the town of Rumford, the sum of \$1,000 annually towards the maintenance of the court rooms, the jury room, the lock-up and other facilities provided in said building for the accommodation of the officials of said county.’
