AN ACT Relating to the Digging Out of Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 75. Digging out raccoons, regulated. From the 15th day of February to the 15th day of October, both days inclusive, no person shall dig out, molest, or destroy, in any way, any ~~fox or~~ raccoon den, den tree ~~or hole~~, or set any trap in any such den, den tree, ~~or hole~~, or remove or cause to be removed from any such den, den tree, ~~or hole of any fox or~~ raccoon except those enclosed in private ~~fox or~~ raccoon ranches.'
