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**AN ACT Relative to Trapping.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 72, additional.** Section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘(j) The use of any other form or device other than the ordinary commercial steel jump trap in the trapping of muskrats is hereby prohibited.’
