AN ACT Relative to Use of Poisons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 49, amended. Section 49 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Whoever for the purpose of killing wolves, foxes, dogs or other animals, and not for the destruction of insects, or vermin in a building, leaves or deposits in any place any poison or poisonous substance shall be subject to the penalties of section 107. **The commissioner may however, grant permits to agents of the Federal Fish and Wildlife Service to use poisons in the destruction of rodents or other vermin.**
