RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Portage Lake.

Fishing in Portage Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, opening Portage Lake in Portage, county of Aroostook, to ice fishing for cusk and smelts only, from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
