**Fishing in Hayden Brook, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Hayden Brook, a tributary to Aroostook River in the town of Oxbow and T. 9, R. 7, T. 10, R. 7, to all fishing.
