STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize Adequate Court Facilities in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Additional county facilities provided for. The board of county commissioners for the county of Oxford is hereby authorized to acquire a lot of land in the town of Rumford, suitable as a site for an addition to the public building, known as the Rumford Municipal Building, which was constructed under the authority of chapter 116 of the private and special laws of 1915, and to construct on said lot an addition to said Rumford municipal building to provide therein for such further facilities as in the judgment of said board are necessary and proper for the accommodation of the superior court, the probate court for said county, the Rumford Falls municipal court, jury rooms, rooms for court and county officers, a law library, and other court requirements and facilities.
- Sec. 2. May issue notes. In order to accomplish the purposes set out in the preceding section said board of county commissioners is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding \$60,000, and in order to procure the whole or any part of said sum, said board is hereby authorized to borrow money temporarily and to issue therefor the interest bearing negotiable notes of said county, and for the purpose of paying or refunding the

indebtedness so created, said board may from time to time issue the interest bearing bonds of said county for a sum not exceeding \$60,000.

Sec. 3. Purposes of act. The purpose of this act is further to enable the board of county commissioners for said county of Oxford to carry out the provisions of chapter 47 of the public laws of 1907, as amended.
