RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Twitchell Pond in Greenwood.

Fishing in tributaries to Twitchell Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing to all smelt fishing the tributaries, wherever situated, to Twitchell Pond in Greenwood, county of Oxford.
