AN ACT Relating to the Administration of State Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1939, c. 223, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 223 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 3. Qualifications. The commissioner of institutional service shall be a person experienced in institutional administration, either as a superintendent, chief medical officer or business manager, or who has had other satisfactory experience in the direction of work of a comparable nature.'
