STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Androscoggin and Kennebec Railway Company.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the exercise of the powers granted under chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1937 has endangered the possibility of proper transportation facilities for the people served by the Androscoggin and Kennebec Railway Company, and

Whereas, proper transportation facilities are necessary to such people, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, c. 86, repealed. Chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby repealed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
