AN ACT Relating to the Androscoggin and Kennebec Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, c. 86, additional. Chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 5-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Rate of fares. Said company, or its successor or successors shall make no charge for fares exceeding 5c for any passenger conveyed by it over any route.'
