## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Municipal Court of Bath.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1937, c. 64, amended.** That part designated 'Sec. 2.' of chapter 64 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 2.** Qualifications of judge and recorder; salary. Said judge and recorder shall be members of the bar of Sagadahoc county, and shall reside during their continuance in office in said county. The judge of said court shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$1450 \$1650 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Said recorder shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$500 \$600 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Both salaries shall be in full for all fees and emoluments of their respective offices.'
