**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land
in Perkins Plantation.**

Conveyance of certain state land; authorized. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to John F. Blanchard, of Dryden, for the sum of \$321.82, whatever interest the state may have in the following described property, to wit:

60 acres in	159 acres—	Lot 1,	R. 5
150 " "	160 " —	Lot 2,	R. 5
20 " "	160 " —	Lot 1,	R. 6
100 " "	160 " —	Lot 3,	R. 6
73 " "	160 " —	Lot 2,	R. 6

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was formerly assessed to James Merchant, and was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1938 for 1936 taxes. Mr. Blanchard is desirous of obtaining these lots by paying the taxes in arrears, as he now holds a mortgage on Mr. Merchant's property. The taxes in arrears with interest and cost from 1936 to 1940, inclusive, amounts to \$321.82. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
