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**AN ACT** Relating to the Brunswick Village Corporation.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1887, c. 172, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 172 of the private and special laws of 1887 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**‘Sec. 1. Corporate limits; corporate name.** The territory in the town of Brunswick, within a radius of ~~one~~  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles from the town house, with the inhabitants thereon, is hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of the Brunswick Village Corporation, with all the rights and privileges granted by the laws of the state, to corporations.’
