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**RESOLVE, in Favor of a Bridge Over the Stillwater River.**

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**Bridge over Stillwater river; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$175,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, to be expended by the state highway commission in the reconstruction of a bridge over the Stillwater river between Orono and the University of Maine campus; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

**The present bridge cannot safely handle the traffic.**

The present bridge is in a state of disrepair and is unsafe for the heavy traffic which it carries. It is necessary to construct a new bridge to replace the present one. The new bridge should be of a design which will allow for the future increase in traffic and will be safe and durable. It is estimated that the cost of the new bridge will be \$1,000,000. It is recommended that the State should appropriate the necessary funds for the construction of the new bridge.
