**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Towns in the Hancock-Sullivan Bridge
District.**

Towns in Hancock-Sullivan Bridge District; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund, in favor of the towns in the Hancock-Sullivan bridge district, the sum of \$4360 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, and the sum of \$4180 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943. These sums to be paid to the Hancock-Sullivan Bridge District for the purpose of retiring bonds and interest and relieving the towns in said district. Any unexpended balance of the foregoing appropriation shall not lapse but shall be credited to the aforesaid district to be used for the aforesaid purposes.
