STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Big and Little Dyer Pond.

Fishing in Big and Little Dyer pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Big and Little Dyer pond in Jefferson, county of Lincoln, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish (except bass) during February and March.
