RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Tacoma Chain of Lakes.

Ice fishing in Tacoma chain of lakes; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue the following rules and regulations:

Opening the Tacoma chain of lakes to ice fishing for pickerel and white perch only on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays of each week during the months of January, February and March, and closing to all fishing from 9 o'clock standard time in the afternoon until sunrise of the following morning.
