RESOLVE, for Screening Sennebec Pond at Union.

Sennebec pond at Union; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$400 be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be taken from the funds available to the department of inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to screen the outlet of Sennebec pond at Union in the county of Knox; provided, however, that no appropriation herein specified for the erection of a screen at the outlet of said pond shall be available until the town in which the outlet of the pond to be screened is situated, shall have in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, vote to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.
