AN ACT Relating to By-laws Regulating Sale of Milk.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 94, ¶ V, amended. The first sentence of paragraph V of section 94 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘V. Make, alter, and amend such orders and by-laws as they shall think necessary and proper for the preservation of life and health and the successful operation of the health laws of the state, subject to the approval of any justice of the superior court; **provided, however, that no such orders or by-laws shall apply to milk, milk distributors or milk producers.**’
