STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Time of Opening and Closing of Polls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 6, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 6 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Whenever in such cities or towns the general prevailing time is daylight saving time, so-called, the hours hereinbefore mentioned shall be construed to mean such daylight saving time, and all notices which contain a statement as to time shall specifically state the kind of time.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 7, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 7 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Whenever in such cities or towns the general prevailing time is daylight saving time, so-called, the hours hereinbefore mentioned shall be construed to mean such daylight saving time, and all notices which contain a statement as to time shall specifically state the kind of time.’

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 8, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 8 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Whenever in such cities or towns the general prevailing time is daylight saving time, so-called, the hours hereinbefore mentioned shall be construed to mean such daylight saving time, and all notices which contain a statement as to time shall specifically state the kind of time.’
