IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Approaches to the Waldo-Hancock Bridge.

Approaches to Waldo-Hancock bridge; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$3000 bc, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds received from the operation of the Waldo-Hancock toll bridge (notwithstanding any previous law relating to the disposal of said funds) to be expended by and under the direction of the highway commission to build a suitable sidewalk from the Waldo-Hancock bridge to the bridge from Verona to Bucksport.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The streets are crowded because of the excess thru traffic and the town has no funds to build a sidewalk. This would not be needed if it were not for the thru traffic.
