STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Road from Brownville to Millinocket.

Road from Brownville to Millinocket; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$45,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, and \$45,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943, for the cutting of a right of way before June 30, 1942 on the road leading from Brownville to Millinocket according to the survey filed with the state highway commission which was made under the authority of the governor and council, and for the construction of said road. Any unexpended balance at the end of either fiscal year shall be available for construction of the same on the next succeeding fiscal year. No part of this appropriation shall be used to compensate land owners for damages to their land caused by the carrying out of the provisions of this resolve. Funds shall be taken for this purpose from the general highway fund, and shall be expended under the supervision of the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road will aid in solving the difficulty of transportation in Aroostook and Penobscot counties.
