RESOLVE, in Favor of the Greenville-Rockwood Road.

Greenville-Rockwood road; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942 to aid in the construction of the road on route No. 15 leading from Greenville to Rockwood; this being a continuation of work done under previous special resolve. Said sum to be taken from the general highway funds. Any unexpended balance at the end of the fiscal year shall be available for construction of the same on any succeeding fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road has been rebuilt in part with state, state aid and federal state aid for approximately 11 miles of the entire 18 miles.
