RESOLVE, in Favor of a Road from Lisbon Falls to Lewiston.

Road from Lisbon Falls to Lewiston; appropriation for. Resolved:
That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$50,000 to be expended under the supervision of the state highway commission out of the general highway funds for building a road from Lisbon Falls to Lewiston. Any unexpended balance shall be available for use on the same project on any succeeding fiscal year.
