**AN ACT Relating to Penalties for Violation of Ordinances of the City of
Bath.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 92, Art. II, additional. Article II of chapter 92 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 9-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 9-A. May enact ordinances; penalty. The city council of the city of Bath is hereby authorized and empowered to enact by-laws, ordinances and regulations for municipal purposes, not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the state. Whoever violates any provision of such by-laws, ordinances or regulations shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 payable to the court to be paid over to the treasurer of the city of Bath, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
