AN ACT Amending the Charter of the City of Auburn.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1917, c. 201, Art. II, § 2, amended. Section 2 of Article II of chapter 201 of the private and special laws of 1917 is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 2. Composition, election, tenure of office, etc. The council shall be composed of the mayor and 5 other members. The members other than the mayor shall be elected one from each ward by and from the qualified voters thereof. The mayor shall be ex officio president of the council. The members of the council shall hold office for a term of 2 years or until their successors are elected and qualified. Members of the council other than the mayor shall ~~serve without compensation~~ **receive as full compensation for the performance of their official duties the sum of \$10 for each meeting of the city council which they shall attend provided that no member of the city council shall be paid an amount in excess of \$400 for such attendance during any one fiscal year.'**
