AN ACT Relating to Employment and Salary of Deputy Clerk of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1921, c. 141, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 141 of the private and special laws of 1921, as amended by chapter 56 of the private and special laws of 1923, is hereby further amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in place thereof the following:

‘Sec. 6. Employment and salary of deputy clerk. The city clerk of the city of Lewiston may employ a chief clerk who may serve as his deputy, at a salary to be determined by the board of finance of the city of Lewiston.’

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform with the provisions hereof.
