AN ACT Relating to Town Meetings of Sanford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 72, § 7, amended. Paragraph (a) of section 7 of chapter 72 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby amended by adding at the end of said paragraph the following:

‘All articles intended for insertion in the warrant for holding the annual town meeting shall be filed in the office of the selectmen on or before midnight of October 15 of each year, and no article shall be inserted in such warrant unless so filed.’

Sec. 2. Reports. The provisions of chapter 218 of the public laws of 1939 hereby are made applicable to said town of Sanford, except that the time so covered shall be from the 1st day of January next prior thereto and end with October 31 of the same year; on or before January 30th next following, a complete financial statement showing total receipts and expenditures and a statement of assets and liabilities shall be made.
