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**AN ACT Relating to the School Committee for Town of Mt. Desert.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 51, repealed.** Chapter 51 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby repealed, and sections 2, 5, 7, and 9 of chapter 97 of the private and special laws of 1929 are re-enacted instead thereof.

**Sec. 2. Referendum.** This act shall take effect when approved only for the purpose of its submission to the legal voters of the town of Mt. Desert for the purpose of its acceptance or rejection at any regular or special town meeting called for that purpose by an appropriate article inserted in the call for such meeting. If a majority of the qualified voters of the town of Mt. Desert voting at such meeting vote in favor of the acceptance of this act, it shall become operative and fully effective. A certificate of such vote shall be filed with the secretary of state by the town clerk.
