STATE OF MAINE .

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Bathing in Damariscotta Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bathing in Damariscotta lake, prohibited. No person shall swim or bathe in the waters of Damariscotta lake, in Nobleboro, within 300 feet of the inlet connecting Damariscotta lake with the so-called Mill pond in the town of Newcastle.

Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be punished by a fine, payable to the state, of not more than \$100.
