STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of High-powered Rifles for Hunting Other Than Deer and Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

High-powered rifles, prohibited. Possession of high powered rifles in the woods of Maine, except when used for military purposes, of a calibre larger than .22 except during the season when it is lawful to hunt deer and bear, is unlawful.
