STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for a Discount from the Established Retail Sale Price upon Sales of Liquor by the State Liquor Commission to Persons Licensed to Sell Liquor to be Consumed on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 301, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 301 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5. Liquor to be bought from commission. All persons licensed under the provisions of section 3 of this act shall purchase all liquor sold under license within the state from the commission, and shall be entitled to a discount from the prices established for retail sale under section 7 of chapter 300 of the public laws of 1933 of not more than 10% upon all such purchases.'
