**AN ACT Amending the Law Relating to Unemployment Compensation
to Further Define Employment.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 192, § 19, amended. Paragraph (1) of section (g) of section 19 of chapter 192 of the public laws of 1935, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection (A).

‘(A) The term employment shall include the service rendered or position held as an officer of a corporation.’
